ENTRIES: The Atwood Harvest Moon Regatta is open to all sailors. Races will be scheduled for MC Scow, Thistle, and Cruising JAM fleets. 3 boat minimum per class.

FEES: After filling out the registration form, you may pay via credit card on the registration website. Payment may also be made on-site during registration via credit card, cash, or check.

Race registration fee includes racing, awards, and social events for **one person**.

- Full 2-day regatta early registration: \$70 (\$80 if paid after August 31)
- Additional crew member full weekend food/beer: \$30

CHECK IN: All registrants must check in at the registration table in the clubhouse lounge Friday night or in the Marr Dining Room Saturday morning to receive wrist bands and pick up shirt preorders.

COMMUNICATIONS: All official communications will only be provided electronically via text message and on the official regatta website: www.atwoodyachtclub.com/harvestmoon. Please be sure to provide your mobile phone number when registering to receive regatta updates.

SAFETY: Boats must comply with all safety requirements prescribed by the State of Ohio.

BERTHING & LAUNCHING: Assistance will be available for launching all yachts. A hoist and ramp are available for launching One Design boats. Bring your own bridle for the hoist. We ask that boats are launched prior to the skipper's meetings each day to ensure timely starts.

AWARDS: Awards will be given on Sunday for 1st-3rd place in each class. Awards will also be presented to top MC Scow sailor in the following divisions: Master - 50 to 59 years, Grand Master - 60 to 69 years.

FOOD SERVICE:

The two-day regatta registration fee includes the following:

- Beer for the weekend
- Hot breakfast Saturday and Sunday
- Bagged lunch Saturday
- BBQ Chicken Dinner Saturday
- Light lunch Sunday

All guests are also welcome to purchase a wide variety of other options off the club's full-service lunch and dinner menu as well as a full bar.

PETS: Pets are now permitted on AYC grounds but must be on a leash and must not cause damage or disturbances. No pets permitted on the club porch. Pets must always be under direct supervision. Owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets.

ALCOHOL POLICY: No alcoholic beverages of any kind are permitted to be brought on to Atwood Yacht Club Grounds under any circumstances. This is a direct violation of the Club's liquor license. **Alcoholic beverages may not be consumed in parking lots or roadways** – please stay in the grassy areas.
